Dr. Maruti Nandan Pd. Twari (b. 1949) M.A., Ph.D., is Professor-Emeritus in the Department of History of Art , Banaras Hindu University.He has headed the Department for three terms under the rotation system. His publications deal extensively with different aspects of Indian Art and Iconography, specially Jaina Art and Iconography. He has many books to his credit including: Jaina Pratimavijnan (Hindi), Elements of Jaina Iconography, Ambika in Jaina Art and Literature, Khajuraho Ka Jaina Puratattva (Hindi), Jaina Kala Tirth: Deogarh (Hindi, joint), Madhya Kalin Bhartiya Murtikala (Hindi, joint), Madhya Kalin Bharatiya Pratimalakshana (Hindi, joint) and Jaina Art and Aesthetics (New Delhi, 2011). His academic pursuits and publications have brought several honours and awards to him. He was invited by the President of India to Rashtrapati Bhavan twice in 1995 and 1997. He was awarded Acharya Narendra Deva Puraskar by Hindi Samsthan (U.P.), Indira Gandhi National Raja Bhasha Award (Delhi), Jaina Award, Shraavanabelgol and Acharya Hemachandra Suri Award, New Delhi. He has been invited for lectures, including Key-note Address at SOAS (London) and at University of Cardiff, U.K.; Nehru Centre, London and Institute of Indology, Berlin (Germany).
